

## National Service Scheme

### Report of NSS activities 2018

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The National Service Scheme of Sant Shiromani Guru Ravidas Government College Sargaon, District- Mungeli (Chhattisgarh) has been participating in the scheme right from its inception. At present the scheme is run by the ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports in Central Government and Department of Higher & Technical Education in State Government.

#### **AIMS AND OBJECTIVES**

1. Understand the community in which students work.
2. Understand themselves in relation to their community.
3. Identify the needs and problems of the community and involve them in problem solving process.
4. Develop among themselves a sense of social and civic responsibility.
5. Utilize their knowledge in finding practical solutions to individual and community problems.
6. Develop competence required for group living and sharing of responsibilities.
7. Gain skills in mobilizing community participation.
8. Acquire leadership qualities and democratic attitude.
9. Develop capacity to meet emergencies and natural disasters
10. Practice national integration and social harmony.

We have an effervescent NSS unit which has been established with a rudimentary objective of providing a dais for the interested students to partake in social work during their free time. The report of the activities of the unit for the academic year 2018-19 has been a record of accomplishments and triumphs.

#### **Enrolment drive and Orientation program:**

Enrollment drive was conducted in the month of July and enrolled 100volunteers for the year 2018-19. In order to orient the newcomers an orientation cum training program was organized on 31st July, 2018.

#### **NSS Report 2018-19**

1. During 2018-19, the NSS Unit of the college organized many activities relating to social service and health awareness.

2. On July 11, 2018 the NSS unit along with the YRC unit created health awareness program for the students of the college.
3. Road Safety Program: NSS Volunteers of College conducted various Road safety programs such as Poster Competition, sending SMS, rally and Seminar on road safety to aware citizens of Sargaon regarding various safety measures which should be adopted while driving the vehicles on the road.
4. On July 27, 2018 the NSS unit along with the YRC unit created health awareness program for the villagers of the village, Salpha.
5. On August 09, 2018 the NSS unit along with the YRC unit conducted a blood checkup camp in the college in which many students and some staff members got their blood checkup and knew about their blood group.
6. AIDS awareness program: AIDS awareness program in the campus, adopted village and slum area were organized by the unit throughout the academic year. 28 volunteers participated in Aids Awareness rally and performed the skit in nearby slum area. The volunteers organized an exhibition of AIDS awareness with the materials supplied by Bilaspur AIDS Control Society and the materials prepared by the volunteers during our Aids awareness campaign. The exhibition was held in the campus during the college on September 05 and 06, 2018. This event was conducted to create awareness about HIV/AIDS, its causes as well as to make people know as to how it can be prevented. This rally was also intended in demolishing the various myths that go around in the society about the spreading of this disease. The volunteers carried posters and yelled out slogans in the local languages Hindi and Chhattisgarhi. The residents of the area had some queries regarding this rally which the volunteers heeded to and cleared all their doubts with patience and understanding. Skit performed by NSS volunteers at the camp site, Sargaon and also in College Campus.
7. On September 25, 2018 the NSS unit along with the YRC unit planted some trees in the village Sawa, Bidbida and inspired the villagers to keep the trees safe and to plant more trees.
8. Energy Saving Project: we have established an Energy Conservation cell in our college involving 20 NSS Volunteers as core volunteers. Our Energy Conservation cell was very active throughout the year. Dr. N. K. Singh imparted training to NSS Volunteers regarding Energy Conservation. The cell had collected Electricity bills of various homes and shops of college students, Volunteers and people of adopted slum pocket to save electricity. The cell had monitored almost 61 houses and shops.
9. On October 12, 2018 the NSS unit along with the YRC unit conducted a health camp in the village Lamti. And expert doctor was invited to give proper remedy and suggestions to the villagers.
10. On November 10, 2018 the NSS unit along with the YRC unit organized the First Aid training camp in the village Kirna and requested the villagers to provide First Aid to those people who are in need of it.
11. On December 17, 2018 the NSS unit along with the YRC unit conducted a training program on Disaster Management and Mitigation in the college camps. Student were trained to adopt such measures which would help them in times of flood, earthquake, storm and other various disasters.
12. On December 29, 2018 the NSS unit along with the YRC unit conducted a training program on Disaster Management and Mitigation in the village (God Gram) Kakedi. Villagers were trained to

adopt such measures which would help them in times of flood, earthquake, storm and other various disasters.

13. Note Book Preparation and Distribution: we have established a Note Book Preparation cell in our college involving 42 NSS Volunteers as core volunteers. Our Note Book Preparation cell was very active throughout the year. They prepared 50 Note books from the used books of last year along with NSS Volunteers and Other College Students. They distributed books to poor students in our adopted slum area.
14. On January 17, 2019 the NSS unit along with the YRC unit distributed fruits among the beggars sitting near Sargaon bus stop.
15. Voting Awareness program: our College had organized Voting Awareness program to aware the students of college and to impart the knowledge about importance of voting. 22 NSS students participated in spread voting awareness Rally. On 25th January 2019 we observed the National Voters Day. On this occasion we organized an invited talk by Prof. U.N. Shriwastav from Govt College Pathariya. 54 students attended this talk.
16. On February 12, 2019 the NSS unit along with the YRC unit distributed medicines among the patients of the primary health center Sargaon.

## NSS Report 2019-20

1. During 2019-20, the NSS Unit of the college organized several activities relating to health awareness. On 14th June 2019 on the occasion of World Blood Donation Day, the students were advised to donate blood as far as possible by the YRC unit.
2. On July 15, 2019 the NSS unit along with the YRC unit created health awareness program for the students of the college.
3. On July 29, 2019 the NSS unit along with the YRC unit created health awareness program for the villagers of the village, Kakedi.
4. World peace day: Nearly 50 students, Gandhian workers, peace activists, advocates, journalists and NGOs participated in a peace march to commemorate Hiroshima Day August 6, 2019 The rally was led from the college to Sargaon market.
5. On August 09, 2019 the NSS unit along with the YRC unit organized the First Aid training camp in the village Torla and requested the villagers to provide First Aid to those people who are in need of it.
6. On August 27, 2019 the NSS unit along with the YRC unit conducted a training program on Disaster Management and Mitigation in the college camps. Students were inspired to adopt such measures which would help them in times of flood, earthquake, storm and other various disasters.
7. On September 09, 2019 the NSS unit along with the YRC unit conducted a training program on Disaster Management and Mitigation in the village (God Gram) Torla. Villagers were trained to adopt such measures which would help them in times of flood, earthquake, storm and other various disasters.
8. Malaria and dengue awareness: On September 15, 2019, 40 students of our College underwent training for ongoing Malaria Awareness Campaigning and conducted rally, skit and survey. The medical officer gave thorough information regarding causative agent of Malaria i.e. Mosquito consisting of their types, source, life span , preventive measures for decreasing the spread of Mosquito, information regarding symptoms of a Malaria infected person.
9. NSS Day Celebration: NSS was formally launched on 24<sup>th</sup> September, 1969, the birth centenary year of the Father of the Nation. Therefore, 24<sup>th</sup> September is celebrated every year as NSS Day .All NSS students of the college celebrated NSS day by performing skits to create awareness on the topics like status of women in India, blood donation , etc , the students also sang songs of NSS. The videos on different social issues were screened on this day.
10. On September 21, 2019 the NSS unit along with the NSS unit along with the YRC unit distributed fruits among the beggars sitting near Bilha Railway station.
11. Swacch Bharat Abhiyan:
  - Pledge was administered at college by students and staff.
  - Posters were put up on the notice boards and camps to aware students about cleanliness.
  - Class to class awareness programmes were organised to aware students.
  - Skit was performed on Swacch bharat abhiyan by NSS Volunteers at Sargaon and Salpha, and nearby slum area and also the college campus.
  - Every day 3 hours devoted by Volunteers on cleanliness by 31 NSS Volunteers at playground of Sargaon.
